

WSD Board Goals for 2014-2015

The Woodburn School District Board of Directors (Board) would like to acknowledge that the district goals will continue to be the three goals outlined in the Strategic Plan, which was developed by our community and adopted by the Board on August 15, 2013.

Goal #1: All students will graduate college and career ready

Goal #2: Build a culture of engagement

Goal #3: Be good stewards of public resources and community trust

Within the framework of those goals the community also worked to establish objectives for the areas where we would measure our progress. District staff has been working on specific targets so that we can hold ourselves accountable for making progress toward achieving our goals. The Board will receive regular reports and updates from district staff. For the 2014-2015 school year we would like to prioritize and further develop strategies in the following areas:

- Report on and regularly communicate with families, students, staff and community information and data on student achievement
- Regularly celebrate and communicate student and program success
- Develop a plan to communicate staff development initiatives
- Develop a bond proposal to place before voters for the May 2015 election

In addition to these priority areas, the board acknowledges that work on data collection for our measures of success is ongoing and district staff will collect and present data as appropriate. The board may ask for additional information and may choose to revise these measures based on data and feedback.

The board has specifically directed the superintendent to prepare and have ready for the board all information and documents related to any board presentation at least 10 days prior to board meeting dates for discussion and possible board action.
