PRESCHOOL PROMISE is a model for a publicly-funded, high-quality preschool system. PRESCHOOL PROMISE leverages high-quality, local and culturally-relevant early child care and education programs and makes them available to children living at up to 200% of the poverty level.

Head Start families may automatically be eligible if they are a foster child, homeless, receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), or a child who is on an Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) or Individualized Education Program (IEP). 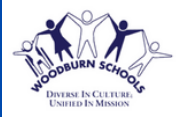
